MANY PEOPLE ARE STRUGGLING

There is an epidemic of anxiety and depression, marital strife, porn, suicidal thoughts, to name a few, and people need on-going care.

DON'T CARRY THESE BURDENS ALONE

Our licensed counselors offer services that help churches and their communities heal. We have seen lives restored when discipleship includes a focus on emotional and mental health.

BENEFITS

REDUCED PRICING

The average cost of a counseling session in NC is \$150/hr. Church partners pay \$100/hr. Not ready to become a partner? Clients only pay \$120/hr.

STAFF CARE

We provide free counseling 4x/ yr. for pastors and a discount for church staff. We also offer a free annual retreat for pastors.

TRAINING

We train your childcare volunteers on mandated reporting. We do workshops on special topics. We coach care group leaders.

PLANT A CHURCH IN PRISON.

On Easter 2023, forty-four women at the Raleigh Correctional Facility put their faith in Jesus Christ. Will you mobilize your church to disciple them? Will you adopt a prison near you?

NETWORK ACCESS

We are currently in 38 of 53 prisons in NC. We support residents who lead Bible Studies in 17 of those prisons. We also connect you with re-entry leaders.

SET-UP TRAINING

We train your volunteers in prison culture, the impact of incarceration, and how to disciple prison residents through letter writing and visitation.


CHRISTMAS CARE
